Street Jesus News:

And if somebody asks about your Christian hope always be ready to explain it, but do this in a gentle and respectful way.

Welcome to the August edition of Street Jesus e news. So here we are the summer holidays have begun and many are looking forward to a nice break away, the roads will be busier and traditionally apart from the big Christian festivals (which many combine with their main holiday) Churches tend to have less events running at this time of the year. You will see from our news though that there are plenty of events in the pipeline to enjoy and help strengthen our faith.

Woodbridge Regatta. The Street Jesus stall was out at the Woodbridge regatta recently where we had a cracking day. £150 was raised from selling African crafts for the Beehive project in Kenya.

We handed out over 100 Beehive flyers and had a number of conversations during the day including one on the relative merits of Islam as opposed to Christianity. We took a number of 'Fruit of the spirit' post it notes which we stapled to the cross. Love and peace were the most popular this time. We also took a number of prayer requests



including some in the confidential box. One of the prayers wished for the destruction of the human race and for Lucifer to be king. This was the first time we had had a request of that nature and were not quite sure if this was meant as a joke or the product of a more distressed mind. Either way we are praying for that person but it does illustrate that we are in a spiritual battle.

Our next missions are on Saturday August 5th at Melton car boot sale 8am- 12 noon. We are also out on the weekend of August 19th/20th but not sure which venue it will be as yet. We are awaiting confirmations. Please visit our facebook page nearer the time for updated information

We will also be at Friday Street car boot sale near Saxmundham on Sunday September 3rd 8am-12noon and we will be holding our bi-annual Yard sale at 7 Featherbroom Gardens on Saturday September 9th on behalf of the Beehive fundraising group.

On July 8th we headed to the Emirates stadium in London to the Just one event hosted by J John. We had pre booked a parking space by a company who hire out private parking spaces attached to residences



of various kinds. When we arrived we found that our car parking space had been taken by somebody else. With an hour to go before the start of the event we circled around the immediate area looking for a place to park and through the maze of streets all we could see were repeated signs for permit parking or clamping warnings. We could find no space anywhere and the stewards were unable to advise us for liability reasons.

By the time we had got further out of London to catch a tube back in to the stadium we would have missed the first hour or so of the event and so we reluctantly decided to head back to Suffolk. To round off a disastrous day we incurred a substantial penalty notice from Islington Council for avoiding a lane which to all intents and purposes was so narrow and with raised kerbs that we considered it to be a cycle lane and when we stopped at the Springfield service area at Chelmsford to take an extended comfort break at Mc Donalds and read the Sunday newspaper we had not noticed the 90 minute parking restriction there ,so incurred another heavy fine as we had exceeded the time limit by six minutes.

When we reflected on and prayed about the day we tried to put a missed event and two fines in the context of the immense suffering that others experience and concluded that our 'bad day at the office' was really inconsequential but we also realised that in our anxiety we had completely forgotten to pray and wondered if our minds had become overly preoccupied and less observant. How often do we forget God when we are anxious and get distracted by our immediate troubles to the point where we cannot 'see' him.

Thanks to the wonders of modern technology though we have been able to view the highlights of the Just one event on youtube in the comfort of our own home but there is really no comparison to being part of a massive Christian gathering and worshipping in such large



numbers There were 23,733 people at the Emirates with around 250,000 listening live on line or on the radio which was just below the estimated number of people (26,000 according to the guardian) who took part in London pride parade on the same day. The difference in the media coverage is interesting and speaks volumes of the current Zeitgeist

The music worship was Provided by Hillsong, Matt Redmond and The London community gospel choir. J John gave the main address and invited guests for interview onto the red sofa. These included The footballer Linvoy Primus, Lord Hastings, Julia Immonen the transatlantic rower and Canon Andrew White the vicar of Bagdadh who relayed their experiences as Christians. Another event is being planned at the Priestfield stadium Gillingham for 8th June 2018 where we hope the parking arrangements will be a little kinder to us. To view highlights of the event see
