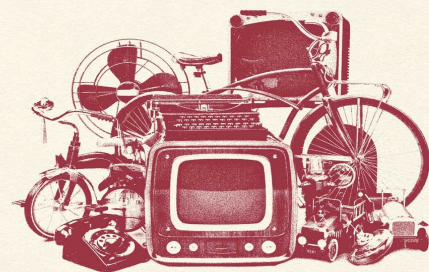
In March we will be at Rendlesham Bentwaters Old Jet monthly market which is held on the old airfield site, this will be a new venue for us so we are very much looking forward to our visit there. We will

not have a collection for the Beehive on that day but will be supporting their own charity Suffolk Accident Rescue Service. Proceeds from the sale of African crafts will go to the Beehive as usual.

It is with eager anticipation then that we look toward the Easter to both reflect and celebrate. On Good Friday we will be taking part in the march of witness in Wickham Market which is an annual event and was very well attended last year. Evangelina the Street Jesus van takes part in the procession, parading the vital message of LOVE-HOPE-FREEDOM-JUST AS YOU ARE.



On Easter Saturday we will be on the Triangle at the top of Hamilton road in Felixstowe 10am -4pm. This is a venue we attended last year and had a very fruitful day, we had a very interesting discussion with a couple who said they were atheists and did not really believe in religion, We were pleased to tell them that we didn't believe in religion either but rather a person. They thought Jesus was ok. They

believed that everything was God and that God was everything which is not really atheism but what we would call pantheism. This of course would include the reality of evil evil so is very much at odds with our Christian view that God is love.

In April we will be holding our bi-annual yard sale here at Featherbroom gardens in Wickham Market. These have become increasingly popular and we hope yet again to be able to support the Beehive Kenya with vital resources and raise awareness of the Christian work there. This will take place on April 7th 9am-4pm.



Looking further ahead to May we are planning four indoor craft markets including two over the late May bank holiday and in June we are booked for the Woodbridge regatta which will be held on Sunday 17th. As you can see we have plenty to look forward too and are very excited about the programme for the year ahead, to love and support people wherever we are, to build good relationships and to point people to the person of Jesus Christ, the greatest love of all. Our bible reading this month is from the book of Titus which reminds us to be obedient to government authorities. This is a difficult concept when we see politicians involved in corruption or wrongdoing or if laws are unjust. The bible also tells us to hunger and thirst for justice and to care for the oppressed. This may seem contradictory. Being obedient to government in the general run prevents anarchy and ensures order but rulers too are judged by God and are to govern justly. We are commanded to speak up for the oppressed. The same passage talks about our need to be humble. This does not mean that we should be timid as some might see it but rather that we should be humble before God and should empty ourselves of our ego and put others first. We are not to have foolish discussions on matters of the law as these are deemed useless and a waste of time, distracting us from the real need to show love for people. This expression of love through prayer may include being a voice for the voiceless even to government.

Remind the believers to submit to the government and its officers. They should be obedient always ready to do what is good. They must not slander anyone and must avoid quarrelling. Instead they must be gentle and show true humility to everyone. Once we too were foolish and disobedient. We were misled and became slaves to many lusts and pleasures. Do not get involved in fruitless discussions about spiritual pedigrees or in quarrels and fights about obedience to Jewish laws. These things are useless and a waste of time. If people are causing divisions among you give a first and second warning. After that have nothing more to do with them. For people like that have turned away from the truth and their own sins condemn them. Titus 3:1-11
