Street Jesus News:

And if somebody asks about your Christian hope always be ready to explain it, but do this in a gentle and respectful way.

1 Peter 3:15-16

Welcome to the November edition of our e-news. With Halloween fast approaching and the thought that many people will be out on the street "Trick or treating" it was good to read that local Christians will be out on our streets for a much more positive reason. The launch of Town pastors in Leiston helped by a grant of £50,000 becomes the 11th town in Suffolk in which pastors operate. Leiston has been plagued with night time anti social behaviour in recent years and if this town follows what has happened in other towns then there is likely to be a significant decline in problems. When town pastors started in Ipswich the first set of statistics made astounding reading. Assaults on Police officers down by 50% ,sexual assaults on females down by 70% ABH down by 48% GBH down 40% and hardened police officers who were both sceptical and concerned for the wellbeing of the pastors were simply amazed. There is no doubt that friendly faces, engaging people in conversation giving out free water and chocolates, supporting people in their troubles changes the atmosphere in a town and makes people feel safer. When this practical help is combined with the power of prayer we become more like Jesus and change for good inevitably happens. Our prayers at Street Jesus are with the new team at Leiston and we hope they enjoy every blessing.

As people now begin to turn their attention to Christmas we reflect on the fact that like the three sages who brought gifts to the baby Jesus we too enjoy giving presents at this time. We again highlight the excellent work of Samaritans purse and operation Christmas child. Shoeboxes filled with toys toiletries and goodies are sent from the uk to places overseas experiencing real poverty. The shoeboxes are distributed by local churches to the delight of the children receiving them. We were very pleased to work with the Beehive fundraising team on Saturday at Kesgrave church. As part of their exhibition of the Saints which is advertised in e-news were craft and fair trade stalls and an enormous selection of cakes as well as a pop up café. We raised £90. There was a good bit of interest in the project particularly the idea of sponsoring individual mothers and children.
