Welcome to the January edition of our e-news. We hope you have enjoyed a very happy Christmas and are looking forward with anticipation to the new year. Its good to remember that God is with us all through the year not just at Christmas and we as a group are planning our programme and looking to Gods grace for the time ahead. We were certainly glad of his provision in the weeks leading up to Christmas. We had two missions out to the Woodbridge and Wickham market Christmas fairs. A total of £780 was raised for the Beehive project Kenya to which we give thanks and praise. A huge thankyou to Andy and Ella Colleran who helped with the set ups and tear downs and also the ladies from the Beehive fundraising group who supported us. Carolyn, Nicola, Julia, Ruth Yvonne and Danni as well as Maxine from Kesgrave who came along to get a taste of the work. As always we had conversations around peoples personal troubles and about Jesus and Christianity in general. It's a great opportunity to lend a listening ear and also challenge some views which are inconsistent with the teachings of Jesus. The subject of religious violence seems a hot topic at the moment both on the internet forums and out on the street. We are confronted with religious violence on our TV screens most days so its very much at the forefront of our minds, reference is often made to the dark side of Christian history namely the crusades and the inquisition. Jesus though warns us of the dangers of political and religious power as expressed by the Pharisees and he teaches against violence of any kind. It is something that still sits in the public mind and something we as Christians need to be honest about. We do not hear so often though about the positive influence of Christianity in the development of Medicine, Education, Science Social provision ,law and order and ideas of justice, human rights and charity. Its important to put this in the balance to which we have also been able to talk about all the amazing things going on in our own local Christian community to help give some perspective to which we are grateful for all the information that you pass on to us. This is not so much boasting about what we do but rather conveying something positive that people can be part of. In all these conversations we are looking to plant seeds and hope that this may be a piece in someone's jigsaw on a journey to faith. We can have these conversations and hand out our alpha booklets, Gideon bibles and tracts but the most important thing is to pray for those whom we touch, that God may go to work in their lives. Many people are eager to be prayed for and we took 17 precious prayer requests over both missions. Our next mission out will be to Leiston co-op on February 25th 10am -3pm. Our next Street Jesus meeting will be on **Monday February 6th 7.30pm At 7 Featherbroom Gardens Wickham Market** You would be most welcome to join us. Bible reading
