Bible reading

For this is what the sovereign lord says. I myself will search and find my sheep. I will be like a shepherd looking for his scattered flock I will find my sheep and rescue them from all the places where they were scattered on that dark and cloudy day. I will bring them back home to their own land of Israel. From among the peoples and nations. I will feed them on the mountains of Israel and by the rivers in all the places where people live. Yes I will give them good pastureland on the high hills of Israel There they will lie down in pleasant places and feed in the lush pastures of the hills.
