Street Jesus News:

And if somebody asks about your Christian hope always be ready to explain it, but do this in a gentle and respectful way.

1 Peter 3:15-16

Welcome to the March edition of our e-news. So here we are on the cusp of lent with the Easter celebrations not far away. It seems like yesterday when I wrote last year of both the reflective and celebratory nature of Easter. Many of us will be looking to fast or give up something for lent. These sacrifices are very important as they help us focus on the true nature of Easter. I have been very taken with the idea of doing good deeds each day and have signed up for 40 acts which gives a daily suggestion on something you can do for somebody during lent. Sacrificing our time or resources is certainly more beneficial than denying ourselves something that we enjoy and fits nicely with Jesus' command for us to love others. We had our first outreach of the year last Saturday at Leiston co-op. £243 was raised on the day. £133 worth of crafts were sold and £110 collected in the bucket. We had many good conversations including pastoral support and affirmation for making Christ known in the community. We had sign ups both for e-news and the Beehive buzz and took a number of prayer requests. We provided a confidential prayer box for the first time for those prayers that are more personal and not appropriate to hang on the prayer tree. This box is kept sealed and will be prayed through along with the other prayer requests in the days ahead. God certainly blessed us in many ways on the day.

Our outreach programme for the year is now beginning to take shape. We have received the street permit for our next outreach at the Felixstowe Triangle on March 25th 10am–3pm. We are still awaiting permissions for Easter Saturday. We are at the Wickham Market Music day on Saturday May 27th and the Hacheston Cream tea and Craft day on Monday May 29th. In June we are at the Friday street car boot with the date still to be confirmed and we have just been accepted to attend the Woodbridge Regatta on Sunday July 16th. We are also hoping to attend the Saxmundham music festival on July 29th.

One of the important things about working on the street is to show the Love of Christ to those whom we meet, this includes being able to give answers to questions that people may have about the Christian faith. This month's e-news includes details of the Unbelievable conference in London that is being hosted by Premier Christian radio. The idea is to equip Christians to be able to speak about their faith with confidence to others. We are gauging interest at the moment with the idea of going as a group. The early bird price is £29 per person which reduces to £26 each if we can get a booking of 10 people or more. If you would be interested in attending please e-mail and let us know.

Our next Street Jesus meeting will be on **Monday March 6th 7.30pm At 7 Featherbroom Gardens Wickham Market**. You would be most welcome to join us.
